## **The Rome Roundtable New Dates: 16 & 17 November 2020**

The Global Foundation confirms that it will convene the fourth edition of its *Rome Roundtable*, originally planned for June, on the new dates of Monday 16 & Tuesday 17 November 2020. A final confirmation will be issued in early September and will depend upon the resumption of international travel.

The *Rome Roundtable* meeting will build upon the momentum of our Global Roundtable series, following on from *Rome* in June 2018 and the *London* and *Paris Roundtables* in June 2019.

Integral to this year's meeting will be a focus on pathways to global recovery, after the pandemic that is currently sweeping the world. How can we help to ensure cohesion and sustainability in the social, economic and environmental dimensions of the 'new normal' that will be required?

Our '*co-operative globalisation*' strategy, as endorsed by Pope Francis and many other world leaders, will remain central to our discussions. The 50 participants taking part will report on their actions and commitments to building a world that better serves the global common good.

The Vatican and the Bank of Italy have confirmed their respective high-level participation, joining a cross-section of leaders from the worlds of business, institutions, academia, civil society, media and other faiths.

As Italy will become the host nation for the G20 in 2021, and co-host of the global COP climate talks, our meeting will provide an early, informal opportunity to contribute to these important agendas for closer international co-operation and action.
