‘Emerging from the Pandemic’

The continuing COVID-19 pandemic has challenged global and national health systems and transformed daily life across the world in unprecedented ways. With few exceptions, the world is still bearing the brunt of continuing infections and impacts on human health, requiring severe restrictions on human movement and extraordinary costs to economies.

The *Global Health Roundtable* will bring together Australian and global leaders to discuss the next steps as COVID-19 becomes endemic.

What needs to be agreed and implemented, between and within nations, to build systems and confidence for overcoming the pandemic, allowing the progressive re-

opening of economies and the free movement of peoples?

Global initiatives such as COVAX are working to overcome vaccine nationalism so that poorer nations also receive early access to vaccines. Is the global vaccine roll-out sufficient to meet the need?

Recent commentary indicates that global pandemics will become much more frequent, requiring higher levels of international cooperation and international governance. How should the world better organise to ensure future global health security?
