The Asia & Australia Roundtable

Hosted by The Global Foundation via Zoom Monday 30th August 2021, 5-7pm AEST

Asia is undergoing an historic economic transformation, on track to become the powerhouse region of the world.

However, is Asia's trajectory towards future prosperity assured?

Health, environment and security concerns are increasingly posing a threat to growth as the continent faces continuing challenges, including:

- the Covid-19 pandemic, which continues to ravage societies across Asia, with the prospect of this and future pandemics impacting on future growth and well-being;
- climate change and environmental degradation, which will require major transitions from current patterns of consumption and towards new energy and urban infrastructures;
- the impact of ongoing geo-political fracturing between the great powers, particularly China and the United States.

Alongside these issues, what of Asia's increasing importance to the world as a whole? Also, where does Australia sit in its relationship with Asia and vice versa?

The Asia & Australia Roundtable will bring together an outstanding group of contributors from Asia, Australia and across the globe to address strategic

challenges and assess possible pathways for future collaboration.

This online forum will build upon global, regional and Australian roundtable discussions convened by the Global Foundation over recent years. At the heart of the Foundation's work is the desire to promote new, positive, win-win forms of international collaboration, through what it calls 'co-operative globalisation', an objective that has been verified and endorsed by many world leaders.

The Asia & Australia Roundtable will seek to facilitate dialogue and shared understanding between citizens from diverse backgrounds, cultures and experiences.

The Asia & Australia Roundtable will also consider practical co-operation, on issues such as greener infrastructure development across Asia, which still faces a huge gap between intent and outcomes.

The outcomes of the roundtable will also inform the next meeting of the Foundation's *Global Roundtable series*, the *Rome Roundtable*, which will be convened as a face-to-face meeting in Rome and Assisi, Italy, in May 2022, subject to travel restrictions.
