We originated in Australia, and also convene a parallel *Australian Roundtable* series, to stimulate thinking and action about Australia's long-term national strategy, in a global context.

Our most significant *Global Roundtable* meetings to date have taken place in Rome, working with the highest levels of the Vatican and with the involvement of a network of committed leaders from central banks, business, academia, peak organisations and civil society.

Subject to Covid restrictions, we will next meet in Rome in November 2020, where participants will report on progress against previous commitments in their respective spheres of endeavour and re-freshed objectives will be discussed and committed to action.
